Why do we need Criteria?

- The Fit for the Future Programme requires an evidence based, transparent and inclusive solutions appraisal process that meets its statutory and assurance requirements.
- The solutions appraisal process needs to enable the programme to sift through a very large number of possible options, the *Long List*, through a smaller number of clinically, financially and deliverable viable options, the *Medium List*, to allow detailed analysis and modelling of a *Short List* to determine the *Preferred Option* or options that it takes out to consultation.



Types of Criteria

There are two types of criteria

1. Essential or Hurdle Criteria: These are applied to the *Long List*
2. Desirable Criteria: These are applied to the *Medium List* and *Short List*

Desirable Criteria

3	Deliverability	Expected time to deliver Co-dependencies	16%
4	Workforce	Operational impact Impact on recruitment, retention, skills	24%
5	Value for money	Costs & income Capital cost to the system Transition costs	12%
6	Strategic fit	Compatibility with the NHS Long Term Plan and One Gloucestershire vision	6%
7	Acceptability	Response to the Fit for the Future Outcome of Engagement Report	2%
